

Co-funding of regional, national and international programmes covering actions **1, 2 and 3**






































"ARTISAN"

- A European Industrial Doctorate (EID a type of ITN) in 4G communications
- 2 partners from 2 countries
 - One in ROI, One in NI
- Inter-sectoral/international research training experience for 4 students
- Funding of 1.1 M€ over 4 years
- Awarded in May 2012
- Horizon 2020: Action 1, Innovative Training Networks











"TARGET-MELANOMA"

- Harnessing high-throughput approaches to identify and validate new melanoma biomarkers
- Funding: 1.7 M€ (1.4 M£) over 4 years
- Partners: 9 partners from 5 countries
 - Coordinated by University College Dublin
 - 4 SMEs and 5 academic institutions
- Horizon 2020: Action 3, Research & Innovation Staff Exchange (RISE)

- National or International Fellowship Schemes
- Co-funded by Marie Curie Actions, but operated by national/international funding agency in European Countries
- Each scheme is different, with different eligibility/mobility rules.
- Over 100 co-funded schemes

	Experienced Researcher (p.a.)	More Experienced Researcher (p.a.)
Living Allowance*, &	€58,000	€87,500
Mobility Allowance*,\$ (€700 or €1000 per month for those with family)	€8,400 or €12,000	€8,400 or €12,000
Research/Training Costs (€800 per month to the host organisation)	€9,600	€9,600
Overheads Contribution* (€700 per month to the host organisation)	€8,400	€8,400
TOTAL	€84,400 or €88,000	€110,900 or €114,500



Evaluation Process




- * Evaluated by at least 3 international experts

- Code: promotes open and transparent recruitment and appraisal
- Embedded in Evaluation
 Criteria for all MC Actions

Human Resources Strategy for Researchers

- "Next-step" encourage mainstreaming of C&C in research entities' policies
- 5-Step Procedure
- Results in Commission acknowledgment (permission to use HR Excellence logo)
- **UCD** are 1st Irish HEI to complete the process
- Others taking part to-date: RCSI, UCC, UL, DCU, TCD, NIUG, WIT
- Shows commitment of UCD to C&C – use this in your MC applications
